- 7. Please pick up any litter and follow the LFE bio security procedures which are in place.
- 8. All dogs must be kept on leads.
- 9. Classes may be split or amalgamated on the day if necessary.
- 10. No horse or pony under the age of 4 years to be ridden at any time.
