1. BBDRC reserves the right to cancel/change classes if insufficient entries are obtained.
2. Riders ride at their own risk.
3. BBDRC and/or LFE will accept no responsibility for any injuries or damaged cause to or by any person, horse or vehicle.
4. The judge's decision is final. Complaints to be lodged in writing alongside a £25 deposit, which is refundable if decision is in favour of the objection.
5. Any behaviour that is deemed inappropriate will result in removal from the show ground. The BBDRC have the right to refuse entry from individuals that have displayed inappropriate behaviour at any event.
6. Anyone mounted on the show ground must be wearing a correctly fitted riding hat to current EU & UK standard. Body protectors are advised in all jumping classes. Riders must wear correct footwear; NO WELLIES! The height of the practice fence should remain at a level suitable for the class which is currently open to competitors.
7. Please pick up any litter and follow the LFE bio security procedures which are in place.
8. All dogs must be kept on leads.
9. Classes may be split or amalgamated on the day if necessary.
10. No horse or pony under the age of 4 years to be ridden at any time.
11. No refunds unless cancelled by the rider in writing prior to closing date.
12. Horses must have up to date Flu Vaccinations to complete at this event.
